## What is an evaluation?

An evaluation is like a snapshot taken during an event or activity. It lets us collect information specific to that event, and related to the [15 National Girl Scout Outcomes](#).

## What is a pre-and-post test study?

Pre and post testing lets us measure the 15 NATIONAL GIRL SCOUT OUTCOMES over time. Girls take a survey at the beginning of the Girl Scout year, and then take a similar survey at the end of the year. Changes that happen over the year in a girl’s attitudes and behaviors, as related to the outcomes can be measured.
