



Leadership Development Pins and Volunteer Learning Leaves

A volunteer is eligible for a Leadership Development Pin when that volunteer has completed Girl Scouting 101, GSEM Orientation, and an Essentials session. A volunteer may receive the Leadership Development pin from his/her service unit at an end of year ceremony or once the training has been completed. Pins are purchased and presented by the Service Unit Coordinator from service unit funds.

Leaves are awarded based on additional training taken which will enhance your abilities and skills as a Girl Scout volunteer. A Green Leaf will be awarded for every 10 hours of training or Service Unit meeting attendance. Five Green Leaves may be exchanged for one Silver Leaf. Five Silver Leaves may be exchanged for one Gold Leaf.
