- Become a registered member of Girl Scouts.
- Agree to a criminal background check in compliance with state law.
- Accept the Girl Scout commitment to work with all without regard to race, ethnicity/culture, religion, socio-economic-status, gender, sexual orientation or differing abilities within diverse communities throughout GSEM.
- Work cooperatively with girls and adults, including staff, volunteers, and families.
- Positive attitude that reflects the acceptance of the mission and goals of GSUSA and GSEM.
- Actively involved or knowledgeable about Girl Scouts.
