Director Biographies

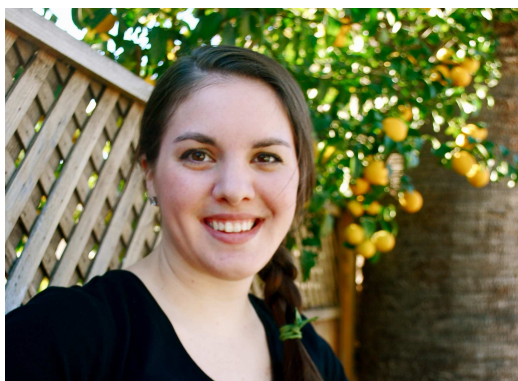
Co-Directors: Sarah "Socks" Clark, Sarah "Bendy" Donahue, and Sarah "Cy" Merianos
