9:45am – 10:45am	Activity Period 1(May include swimming, badge work, crafts, games, archery, challenge course, nature exploration and more)
11:00am – 12:00pm	Activity Period 2(May include swimming, badge work, crafts, games, archery, challenge course, nature exploration and more)
12:00pm – 12:35pm	Lunch at home sites (campers bring their lunches)
12:45pm – 1:45pm	Activity Period 3(May include swimming, badge work, crafts, games, archery, challenge course, nature exploration and more)
