5:45pm	Evening Flag Ceremony
6:00pm – 7:00pm	Dinner
7:00pm – 8:00 pm	Evening Program which could include arts & crafts project, star gazing, all-camp activity, twilight swim, etc.
8:00pm – 9:00pm	Campfire and daily reflection
9:00pm – 9:30pm	Getting ready for bed
9:30pm	Quiet time
10:00pm	Lights out

Each program will also include a sampling of swimming, outdoor cooking, boating, arts & crafts and adventure activities.
