

## A Typical Day at Camp Pennacook at the Center

9:00am – 9:15am	Arrive at camp and Opening Flag Ceremony (Units take turns conducting the ceremony each day, announcements, theme activity, challenge of the day)
9:15am – 12:00pm	Program Areas (girls and their counselors swim, go to arts and crafts, do nature activities, archery, practice outdoor skills, go on a hike, etc.)
12:00pm – 12:45pm	Lunch (Campers bring their lunches, and each unit has a shaded area with picnic tables where they eat together.)
12:45pm – 3:15pm	Afternoon Programs (wide games, all-camp challenges, games, individual choice activities, etc.)
3:15pm – 3:30pm	Kapers (girls help clean up their unit and around camp)
3:30pm – 4:00pm	Closing Flag Ceremony (end-of the-day events such as awards, announcements, or celebrations)
4:00pm	Head for home

Campers will swim at least once a day and will participate in skill strengthening. Once a week, campers will plan a cookout lunch or dessert they'll prepare together over a campfire. All girls will participate in an all camp once a week at Camp Pennacook at the Center.
