1:30pm – 5:45pm	Afternoon activities based upon what the girls plan and program theme which could include boating, crafts, games, free swim, challenge course, riding lessons, trips out of camp, archery, drama, etc.
5:45pm	Singing Time
6:00pm – 7:00pm	Dinner
7:00pm – 8:00 pm	Evening activity which may include all-camp, star gazing, twilight swim, etc)
8:30pm – 9:00pm	Quiet unit activity which may include evening campfire, daily reflection, plan for tomorrow, etc
9:00pm – 9:30pm	Getting ready for bed (Actual Bed Time Varies by Age)

Activities will be based on what the girls plan which happens at the beginning of each session as well as the theme of the program. Each program will also include a sampling of swimming, outdoor cooking, boating, arts & crafts and adventure activities. Girls will go home at the end of the session with a badge sheet listing what badges the girls worked towards that session.
