



WHAT TO PACK FOR YOUR STAY AT RESIDENT CAMP

Bring enough of the following items for your stay at camp.

Shirts	T-shirts	Underwear (bring extra)
Socks (bring extra)	Long pants (at least 2 pair)	Long sleeved shirts
2 bathing suits	PJ's	Jacket
Bandana	Hat with Brim	Rain Gear
2 pairs of sneakers that tie (REQUIRED)	Flip flops (for the shower and beach ONLY)	Sleeping Bag or sheets to cover mattress
Pillow	Mess Kit (plastic plate, cup, fork, spoon, bowl)	Flashlight (with extra batteries)
Water bottle (a must)	Beach Towel	Shower towel, face cloth
Soap, deodorant, etc.	Paper, addresses, stamps	Stick or lotion sunscreen
Stick or lotion bug repellent (no spray)	Day pack or backpack	Bug net (optional but highly recommended for Runels & Favorite) Available at Council Shop

A separate packing list for specialty programs will be available in your Resident Camper Handbook that you will receive with your confirmation packet.

Many of the items listed above are available at the council shops located in Middleboro, Waltham and N. Andover.

VALUABLES

The following items are **not allowed** at camp and should be left at home: radios, CD players, Ipods, MP3's, Game Boys, other electronic devices, cell phones. These items will be confiscated by the director and kept in the camp office until departure from camp.

Cameras & film, address book, t-shirt to tie-dye, spending money for camp store (items range from \$1 to \$30).
